1 Overview


The goal of this document is to provide an overview of Virtual Learning Academy or VLA. It will familiarize you with the most common features of the application.

This manual starts by explaining how to login to VLA and what information is contained on the home page. The next section describes how to view student information such as demographics, classes and grades. The following section explains the types of reports that can be run. The final two sections explain the messaging system used to interact with students and the help system.

2 Login & Home Page

2.1 Login

The *Login* page is the first page of the application. A valid username and password is required in order to proceed.



2.2 Home Page

The *Home Page* is the first page you will see after logging in. The following sections explain the individual parts of this page.



2.2.1 Toolbar

The toolbar is located in the top right corner of the *Home Page* and provides access to some commonly used features of VLA. The toolbar can be found on every page.

2.2.2 Reports

Shows teachers who have not logged in within a time frame.

Teacher Seat Time Report

Shows a log of teacher activity.

Units To Grade Report

Shows all units that have not been graded.

Class Rosters

Shows class rosters by teacher

Course Teacher Assignment Report

Shows teachers who can teach a course.

Student Lists

Shows students by district.

Student Inactivity Report

Shows students who have not logged in within a time frame.

Student Seat Time Report

Shows a log of student activity.

Course Grades Report

Shows student grades for a particular course.

Student Progress Report

Shows student grades and progress.

Class Count Report

Shows the number of active students in each class.



2.2.4 New Messages


This section displays unread and not answered messages. Click on the name in the 'From' column to view the message.



3 Student Information

3.1 Students Page

The *Students* page allows you to search for students using a variety of search criteria. Clicking on the icon next to the student's name will take you to the *Student Information* page where you view demographics, classes and account information. Clicking the 'View As' link takes you to the 'View As the Student' page. What this means is that when you click this link you will be taken to the homepage of the student. This is the exact same page the student sees when they login. Then you can then travel through the VLA application as the student. This feature can be used to assist students who are having problems with VLA. Also, this allows you to see their units and grades.




3.2 Student Information


3.2.1 Main View

The Classes view shows a list of a student's classes and their grades.




Clicking on the 'View' link will take you to the My Units page where you can view grades for individual units.

The Accounts view shows student login and email information.





4.1 Teacher Inactivity Report


The *Teacher Inactivity Report* shows teachers who have not logged in within a certain time frame.





4.2 Teacher Seat Time Report


The Teacher Seat Time Report shows a log of teacher activity.


The *Units to Grade Report* shows all units that have not been graded.


Class Rosters show a teacher's roster.





4.5 Course Teacher Assignment Report


The *Course Teacher Assignment Report* shows the teachers who can teach a particular course.






4.6 Student Lists


Student Lists shows the students in a district or school.






4.7 Student Inactivity Report


The *Student Inactivity Report* shows students who have not logged in within a certain time frame.






4.8 Student Seat Time Report


The Student Seat Time Report shows a log of student activity.






4.9 Course Grades Report


The Course Grades Report shows student grades for a particular course.






4.10 Student Progress Report

The Student Progress Report shows student grades and progress.






5 Messaging


The messaging system allows you to send and receive messages from students.
